The Story

Everyone likes a good story. Much of the success of entertainment these days depends on a well told story. If the story stinks it will surely be a failure. This is true in TV, movies, books, games, even the songs we listen to. Think about what happens when you get together with friends. Whether it's in worship, at lunch, over a cup of coffee, or at work; much of the time is spent telling stories. Often they are our stories, or ones we've heard, sometimes they are embellished to make a point. If we are in a friendly bunch, we laugh, we smile, and we relax.

Not surprisingly, Jesus was a master storyteller. This quarter in Sunday school, the Gospel Project takes us into the stories Jesus told. These stories relate directly to the big picture of the Bible. They are simple, yet succinct. In Mark 1:15 Jesus says "...The kingdom of God is near. Repent and believe the good news." If God is here now, now what? Repent and believe. Simple.

I believe we often complicate the message. We really want to get it right; we strive to get all the details in the first presentation. Then out of fear of messing it up and that they will be lost because of it, we add too much, and make it more complicated.

A complicated message is ineffective. The kingdom of God is at hand. It is now. What are you going to do? What will you say? This good news is easy to tell. How God works with the people we talk with is not up to us, they may need prodding for years, or they could turn and believe on the same day. If we can answer questions, we should. But restructuring a heart is the work of God. Letting each heart know that God cares is telling a simple story. "...The kingdom of God is near. Repent and believe the good news." Mark 1:15
