Life Groups

On September 10, we will begin our third year of Life Groups. We believe this will be a great opportunity to better connect with each other and to invite friends to learn more about Christ as we continue growing, working and sharing together. As a reminder to all of us and an introduction for our newer members, I thought it might be good to share again the series of articles that explained the purpose of Life Groups and the scriptural example of small groups in the New Testament. This is the first of four part series by Dr. Dan Williams, a long time minister and expert on small group ministries in the churches of Christ. - Brian

Small groups were a practice that was a scriptural part of the church from the very beginning of New Testament Christianity. When small groups are done right there is nothing more scriptural, for four reasons:

First, in the description of the very first church of Christ, the great Jerusalem church, we read:

"Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts" - Acts 2:46

Note that the Biblical passage describes two levels of the church's "togetherness." The first was in the "temple courts" - which would have likely been the only public space large enough for a congregation of more than 3000 members (Acts 2:41; 2:47: 4:4).

The second level was in their "homes." There is simply NO way for that second level to be logistically possible without some sort of small group system, because NO scholar or commentary I have ever read has suggested that all 3000+ members were crammed together in one living room! The only possible conclusion is that the Jerusalem Christians came up with some method of providing members with access to smaller, home-based gatherings – which is the very definition of a small group ministry!
