## Now What?

We have entered a season. More precisely, we have entered a series of seasons. Thanksgiving started a time of reflection leading to gratitude. Coming up is Christmas, a time when much of the worlds' focus turns to Jesus. Finally, the New Year heralds change. These events have an uncanny parallel in the congregations' present circumstances.

These seasons can be beneficial for the congregation. We can reflect on where we are as a church. Are we doing what we *should* be doing? Are we staying on mission? (Matthew 28:16-20) What are we doing that's ineffective? Should we stop doing it? Are we reaching our community? If not, how can we do that well? Does the community know us? Are we meeting the needs of our members? Are we encouraging everyone to grow? If not, why not?

Remember, the congregation has changed a lot in three and a half years. As we continue to grow, we will continually need to adjust. What works for a family of 120, doesn't work the same for 150, or 200. Know that we are looking for an interim minister (or series of ministers), getting information together to create a minister search committee, and planning for a transition we hope will happen over the summer.

Our first step involves diving deep into prayer. Will you join us? God is preparing a minister for the church even now. Are we going to be ready to receive him? Mike
