When You Do

Last week in our Wednesday night Bible study, we talked about the beginning of Matthew 6. Jesus challenges us in that section to make sure that our giving, praying and fasting is done for God rather than to be seen by men. In this case, He suggests doing those things in secret. Christians today may be keeping that part of the command a little too well.

We get uncomfortable sometimes talking about how much we give, how often we pray and whether we fast. We've gone past the idea of secret and made those things so personal that we might be afraid to discuss them at all. For most of us, we will find one of our weakest spiritual discipline among those three. It's worth noting, though, how Jesus introduces each of those topics: "When you give..." "When you pray..." "When you fast..." They are not "ifs," they are "whens." So the question Jesus is answering is how we should do these things. That might make us ask the question, "Are we doing these things at all?" If not, let's get to work on making these disciplines a regular part of our lives, and let's do them to the glory of God.
