Paul tells the Ephesians to imitate God. (Eph. 5:1) They weren't to be God, but to commit to the lifestyle of being God imitators. We put on Christ and learn in a myriad of ways to keep on imitating Him.

That is what leads us to be truly 'becoming imitators of God.'
