In my first year of youth ministry, I attended the National Youth Workers Convention in Dallas, Texas. If you haven't been, I'm not sure how to describe a weekend spent with 6000 youth ministers. It's probably unlike any conference you've been to or any trip you've taken. At that convention, I heard Tony Campolo speak. He closed his remarks with his take on a sermon by S.M. Lockridge: "It's Friday, but Sunday's Coming."

In this sermon, he contrasted the darkness that came with the Friday of the last week of Jesus and the hope that Sunday would bring. With each contrast he grew louder, and continued the same rhythm, "It's Friday, but Sunday's coming." It's a rhythm we might need to hear more clearly. For many of us, it feels like the darkness of Friday has taken control in our lives. Some mornings, we might wake up and feel hopeless. But like Jesus who we follow, our stories do not end with Friday. We have hope in the resurrection.
