### **REACHING OUT**

One important thing, as the church, is to reach out with the Word into the community, and to share the Good News with those who don't come to worship or who don't have the opportunity to do so.

Sharing some of our *outreach*: on the fourth Monday of each month 4 or 5 men go to the Eugene Mission to do the Chapel Service. We lead the singing, prayers, and those men who are willing, give a short lesson from God's Word. The men at the Eugene Mission, who attend Chapel, must feel the need to Worship because they voluntarily attend.

Being involved with the Mission one evening a month we have learned more of what the Mission is doing. Not only do they feed a lot of men each day and house them for the evening, but more important, they offer—to those who volunteer—the Eugene Mission's "Wellness Program". The Wellness Program helps them to get off of drugs and alcohol, etc. It is a year long program and at the end of the program they have a graduation ceremony where they are recognized in becoming free of their addictions; and, some have already found jobs. This is an excellent program to help the homeless, those who are addicted—men and women—to get their lives back.

Another outreach is singing at Nursing Homes, where the men's ensemble does that occasionally on Sunday afternoons.

There is an after-school program, which a faithful family has taught for many years, and are to be congratulated. They, too, sing in Nursing Homes, and also to some of our own shut-ins.

Those are just a few small ways we are reaching into our community.

When we read his letters, it can be an interesting window into his relationship with the church in different locations. The Christian life is 24/7. We should be working daily to live the kind of lives that the Thessalonian Christians were: lives that would be noticed for good works of faith, hope and love. We don't do it for the commendation. We do it to honor our God and help people see Him more clearly.
