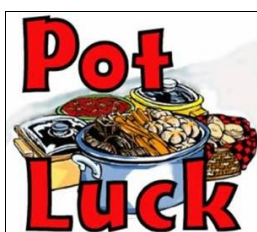

Last Wednesday night our adult Bible class began a study of the book of Hebrews. As the book opens, the writer begins his thoughts by making a case for the superiority of Christ. The audience of the book came from a Jewish heritage, so they had a long history with God and His people. They revered men of God like Moses and Abraham. Like us they were also fascinated with angels, messengers sent by God Himself. The writer of Hebrews begins by reminding them that although all those were great, they are nothing when compared to Jesus.

Our study brought a question to my mind this week. What do we need to be reminded that Jesus is greater than in our lives? Jesus is greater than Alabama football. (He's also greater than Oregon football; you're not off the hook.) Jesus is greater than our presidential candidate or political party. Jesus is greater than our favorite historical figures. Jesus is greater than our favorite movie star. Jesus is greater than our family background (whether it is good or bad). Jesus is greater than our 401k. Jesus is greater than our jobs and our hobbies. Jesus is greater than our problems. We sometimes place those things in a place of higher importance than Jesus in our lives. We sometimes trust in them more than we trust in Him. This week, let's set all of those things aside and give Jesus the place that should be His. Jesus is greater.
