

We've spent the last couple weeks in our Wednesday night Bible study talking about angels. Throughout history many people, even some who are not religious, have been fascinated with these beings. In fact the Greek word that refers to angels in the New Testament is "angellos," which is literally translated as "messenger." Beyond the imagery of halos and wings, they function to deliver messages from God.

Sometimes we get caught up in the fascination with how God might deliver a message to people and we forget the point. God wants a relationship with His people. He began by speaking to people directly in the garden and early in the Bible. He sent prophets later in the Old Testament. Scattered throughout scripture He sent angels with messages. The New Testament begins with Him sending His only Son. Now He gives us His Spirit to help guide and comfort. God loves us enough to reach out to us again and again. 
