I went to high school in Milton, WV and left school to join the Marine Corp. I was trained for combat in North Korea. I worked for about a year in Sidney, Ohio for Stollies Refrigeration and then then re-entered the military, this time in the Air Force. I served in North Bend Oregon, Canada and Tennessee.

I was baptized at 10th and Washington Church in 1961. On December 10th, 1961 I married Shirley Newingham in Eugene. We raised two daughters and gave a home to about 12 teenage foster girls. We loved to go camping at the coast.

I worked for 27 years for Wildish Sand and Gravel, driving the triple tankers on the highway as well as other trucks in the fleet. My interest included taking out my boat and fishing for salmon and going hunting for deer and elk. I was a deacon for the Eugene Church of Christ and a long time member of the McKenzie A's Model A car club. I have driven a motorhome across the country many times in the last fifteen years, seeing lots of relatives and lots of God's beautiful country. A highlight was visiting the Church in Hurricane WV.


