Join the Kare-N-Bear Team

When children are removed from their homes, it is often in an emergency situation and they leave with nothing. Our program helps make this traumatic situation a little better by providing a care package full of essential items (diapers, pajamas, toothbrushes, shampoo, socks, etc) as well as a handcrafted bear and bag for each child. We provide for children, newborns through age 12. Established in 1995, our Kare-n-Bear program has made a difference in the lives of over 2500 children.



How can you get involved?

Several times a year we'll put out "the bear" in the lobby so each of us has the opportunity to purchase specific items for the care packages. In addition to that we have three specific areas for volunteers.

Sewer Using provided fabric, directions and pattern, this team sews/stuffs the bear and bags. You can sew at home or during periodic sewing work days *(usually after Tuesday morning Ladies Bible Class)*.

<u>Prep</u> For non-sewers, we'll provide the pattern and fabric and you can cut out the patterns at home.

Assembler Periodically we'll gather and assemble all the components to prep for delivery to Social Services.
