I was born in eastern Oregon to a family of farmers and ranchers. We lived in a small rural community of Harper, Oregon and were members of the Church of Christ there. My father served as an Elder and Minister. My relatives on both sides of my family were Church of Christ with many being preachers, Elders and Deacons. My grandparents are from Molallo, Oregon and Sumner, Nebraska. Except for a couple of years during WWII, we lived in Eastern Oregon. My father was even teased about being a Marine Lt. who taught Sunday school while at Camp Pendleton. In the book "Christians on the Oregon Trail" there are stories about the Dart side of the family, Charles Bisby Dart that are documented by my Uncle Lowell Dart. My father loved cottage meetings, and we went as a family to Burns and other towns a lot where he help cottage meetings. All of the small congregations would get together for singings, potlucks, parties and yearly camp outs. Our family went to the family camp up at Ivydale, our church camp out of Boise. Then teen camp with all the teens from the area. So many wonderful memories and friendships. I learned how a bond of Christ was so important in our lives. One year at camp, I felt the desire to be baptized. My father baptized me the next Sunday. I grew up with many wonderful Christian teachers in Sunday school (flannel boards). Our family grew up singing and singing in church. I learned alto from my Grandmother Vaye Flock. Even today our family will get together for singing. That is all my mother requested at her memorial that we do.

In 1970 I moved to Eugene for my job as a medical specialist in cancer. I went to the 10th and Washington Street church. I was a helper along with Azalea's son Claude on the Joy Bus and for many years I taught children's classes. The people of the church and my family have encouraged and influenced my life so much. I realize now more than ever, the benefit of growing up in a Christ loving family.
