My parent's, Homer and Grace Newingham were raised in Kansas. They moved to California and worked at many different jobs from 1938-1941. Upon returning to Kansas I was born in Wilson Colorado. in June 1942 and when I was two months old they moved to Los Animas, Colorado where dad worked on the Caddis Dam for about a year. After this job ended we moved to Idaho. After a few weeks Dad came home (Boise area) and said we were leaving. He contacted his brother Charlie in Eugene and was able to get a job. At this time gas was rationed and Dad was not allowed to get gas ration stamps until he had a job.

In Eugene we lived in an apartment about 2 blocks from 10th & Washington. This would have been in 1944. In November 1945 we moved to a house at 1944 City View, which was to remain the family home until Mother moved in the summer of 2004. I grew up on a little dirt road in the country that now is part of the city of Eugene and has been paved for many years.

As a child I worked raking leaves for the Casses and also going in the bean field. I worked in their home during my high school summers. I was lucky to be a part of a large youth group at church. We were always doing activities together. I was baptized in 1954 at 10th & Washington. I graduated from South Eugene in 1960 and then went to Eugene Beauty College 1960-1961. I married Larry in 1961 and we had two daughters, Christine and Rhonda. I worked about 3 years for Oregon Outfitters as well as a few other jobs then worked for 33 years at C & K Petroleum Equipment Co. doing bookkeeping for 3 locations as well as other office work and sales of air compressors, gas pump and service station equipment. I retired December 31, 2001.

I have done many crafts and other projects over the years. Sewed lots of stuffed animals for a fund raiser for Cascade Christian College, sewed lots of bears and bags for foster children, made lots of porcelain dolls and for about 10 years cared for teenage foster girls. Larry and I have been very involved with the McKenzie A's Car Club. Starting in the summer of 2002 we've made several trips across the country making many new friends, visiting relatives, seeing lots of sights and doing genealogy. A highlight of these trips was all the churches we visited.
