# **Candidate evaluation**

In order to get feedback from the congregation on the ministers trying out, we are offering two ways to evaluate them.

First, and the preferred way, on Monday after each visit an email will be sent out with a link to the survey. This can be done with a computer or via internet by phone. Data from that survey will be automatically compiled and readily available. The survey will be open from Monday through Saturday of the week after the evaluation weekend.

Second, we will have paper forms to hand out on the Sunday the candidate is preaching. Those forms will have to be entered into the online database by hand. Paper surveys will be accepted until Saturday of the week after each evaluation weekend but the data will not be available until later.

Please take the time to prayerfully and thoughtfully consider each of the three men. Your input will be helpful for the search committee. Mike and Ruth married in 1985. We lived in a bedroom community of New York City for almost 30 years. Mike worked as a video editor and Ruth as a nurse in healthcare. Both of our children were born back east.
