Congregational Fast this Saturday September 7th

Join your church family in a day of fasting and prayer for relationships!

I believe the Lord does amazing things when we unite together in common work and purposes. One way the church has done this throughout the centuries is through combining fasting with prayer.

You can choose the meal(s) and the time(s). You know your body and what you are capable of, and it is always good to start small and build from there. Choose what meals you plan to fast and pray through

ahead of time and make a commitment to the Lord.

Critical Areas where we are praying for spiritual breakthrough:

- I. The salvation of our children: Our kids face a lot of difficult things and it seems to come at them at earlier and earlier ages. Pray for the protection of our children as they start back to school. Pray for godly friends and mentors to help our children. Some of our kids have been asking for a close friend for a long time now. Pray for circumstances and opportunities for our young people to grow in faith and love for the Lord. Pray against people, circumstances, and spiritual forces of evil that would confuse our children, destroy their innocence, tempt them, abuse them, and otherwise draw their hearts away from God.
- 2. **Pray for our marriages** of this congregation. We have marriages that are under attack and good couples of this church who are really struggling. Strong marriages make strong families and this also affects our children. Pray for good communication, pray for lies to be exposed, pray for faith to grow, pray for repentance and forgiveness, pray for healing and joy, pray for sexual integrity and satisfaction in our marriages.
- 3. The unity of this church: For some, things have been changing way too fast at the Eugene Church of Christ, for others, not near fast enough. The goal is not to try and make everyone happy, but to love the Lord and each other well, and to be faithful to those things that are close to the heart of God. Pray against a spirit of complaining, pray against pride, selfishness, and discontent. Pray for the Lord to reveal the brokenness of your own heart to you, and pray for a spirit of humility.
- 4. Fast and pray for opportunities to build **deeper relationships:** with our fringe members and those who don't feel like they fit in very well. Pray for the blessing of our new Care Team Ministry who are committing to works of visitation and acts of hospitality. Pray for the gift of enjoying each others company, pray for good works to be done in a spirit of teamwork. Pray for times of refreshing through play, joy, laughter, and celebration. Pray for opportunities to share our true selves with trustworthy brothers and sisters: to confess sins, to encourage, to share our hopes and desires, and to intercede for one another.
