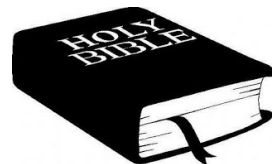

STRUCTURING OUR PRAYER TIME—(Building our personal prayers on the Lord's Prayer)

1. Begin with a moment of silence. Take some deep breaths and still yourself. Bring awareness of God's presence before your mind. "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name," (Matthew 6:9)
2. Prayer for the Mission of God: "Help me align with your mission and purposes Lord." Pray for the Lord's will to be done in your life, your family, your church, your community, your nation, and the world. "Your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven." (Matthew 6:10)
3. Prayer for Provision: Prayer for your personal needs and desires... for the Lord to provide for the needs of you and your family. "Give us today our daily bread." (Matthew 6:11)
4. Prayer for Repentance: Asking for the Lord's forgiveness from personal sin. Praying for those who have wronged you. Asking the Lord to help you forgive. "Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors." (Matthew 6:12)
5. Prayer for Protection: For the strength and wisdom to overcome temptation. For protection from every form and source of evil. "And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one." (Matthew 6:13)

Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. 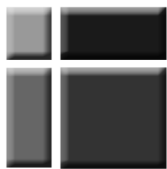
