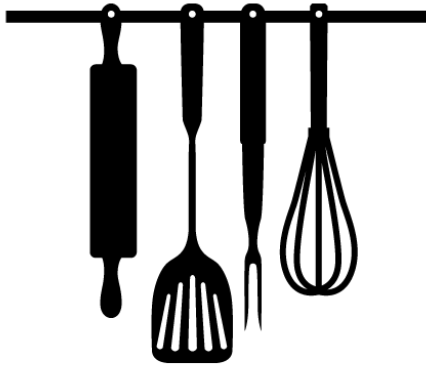
Kitchen Treasure Swap

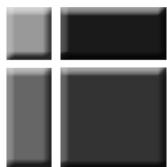
