2021 has been a challenging year with all the government restrictions in place throughout the world to deal with the pandemic. However, the work is continuing! I have already spent much of the year in West Africa, with numerous graduations and teaching assignments. Plans are underway for Karen, Brenda, and Kathy to return to Ghana later this year to resume their women's programs. Everything is not back to normal yet, but we are moving in that direction.

Our preaching schools are all fully open, with hundreds of students studying in the classroom. We continue to bring many souls to Christ, and we have planted several congregations over the last few weeks. Many West African land borders remain closed, but it is not keeping us from doing the work.


