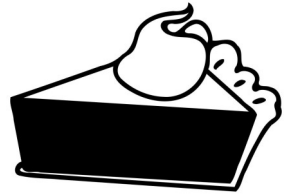

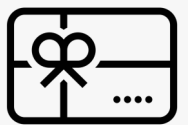

Grocery store gift cards will be handed out in lieu of food baskets. The Church Office is still taking names for Thanksgiving cards to WinCo.



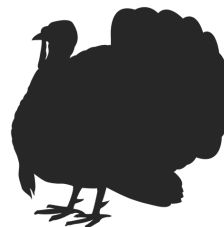
A Short Break for Tuesday Ladies Bible Class
